

WAUSAU AREA USBC WOMEN'S LOCAL TOURNAMENT RULES

Entry will be open only to members of the Wausau Area USBC. Entrants shall use their highest league average as of the end of the previous winter season, provided they have bowled 21 games or more. If no previous winter season average, an entrant shall use the highest average as of the end of the previous summer season, provided she has bowled 21 games or more. If no previous winter or summer average then use average of at least 12 games as of January 22, 2012, subject to the approval of the Tournament Manager. If none of the above apply, entrant must use the scratch figure of 170. Incorrect average reporting will result in forfeiture of prize money.

All USBC tournament rules are in effect for this tournament. Bowlers are responsible for knowledge of these rules. **Bowlers MUST RERATE if current average is 15 or more pins higher than 2010-11 book average at the time of bowling in this tournament.** Bowlers will use the HIGHEST entry average throughout this tournament if bowling more than once.

Entrants are allowed to bowl in Team Event as many times as they wish. Everyone must bowl when scheduled.

Entries must be accompanied by full amount of fees - \$12.00 per bowler (\$60.00 per team). Money Order or Bank Draft (preferred) and completed entry form must be in Secretary's hands before you bowl. Team trophies to be provided by Marathon Lanes. Championship patches courtesy of USBC.

No entries shall be accepted after closing date, except those postmarked the first post office business day after the entry closing date.

A sub shall be allowed, if one is available, in case of disability after a game has started. Only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count if a sub is not available.

Teams will bowl all three (3) games on their scheduled pair of lanes.

No resin or foreign substance will be allowed on lanes, runways, or used on a ball or on bowler's shoe. A violation of this rule will cause forfeiture.

Any player or team arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled.

In the event a team is unopposed on a pair of lanes, each frame shall be completed on one lane before the next frame is started on the adjoining lane.

Pacers shall not be allowed in the Tournament.

Bowlers should be suitably attired.

In the event of a first-place tie, co-champions will be declared.

This will be a "Single-Class, Handicap" tournament. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between 225 and the bowler's highest average.
